Waschboklân chaubên wachtahên aikâna

**daf chnân schwoken l'chajabên-And forgive us of our trespasses as we
forgive those who trespass against us.**

Wela tachlân l'nesjuna-Lead us not into temptation.

Let us not be lost in superficial things (materialism, common temptations),

ela patzân min bischa-Deliver us from evil.
