d'bwaschmâja-Who art in heaven who fills all realms of sound, light and vibration.

Nethkâdasch schmach-Hallowed be thy name

May Your light be experienced in my utmost holiest.

Têtê malkuthach-Thy Kingdom come

Your Heavenly Domain approaches.

Nehwê tzevjânach aikâna d'bwaschmâja af b'arha-Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven.

Let Your will come true - in the universe (all that vibrates) just as on earth (that is material and dense).

Hawvlân lachma d'sûnkanân jaomâna-Give us this day our daily bread Give us wisdom (understanding, assistance) for our daily need,

Waschboklân chaubên wachtahên aikâna daf chnân schwoken l'chaijabên-And forgive us of our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us.

detach the fetters of faults that bind us, (karma) like we let go the guilt of others.

Wela tachlân l'nesjuna-Lead us not into temptation.

Let us not be lost in superficial things (materialism, common temptations),

ela patzân min bischa-Deliver us from evil. but let us be freed from that what keeps us off from our true purpose.
